

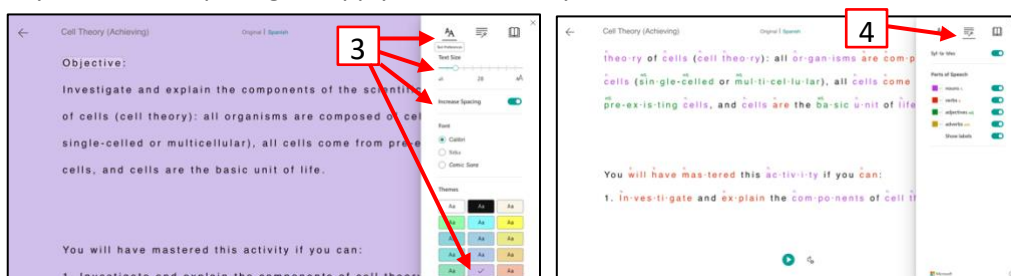
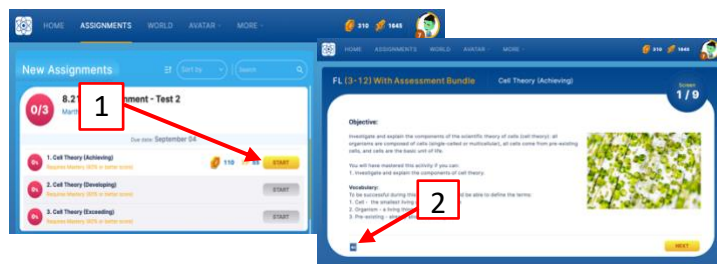

How to Use the Immersive Reader and Language Translator Tools (for students)

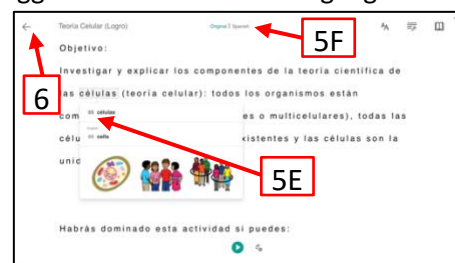
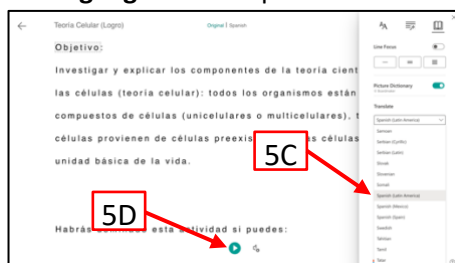
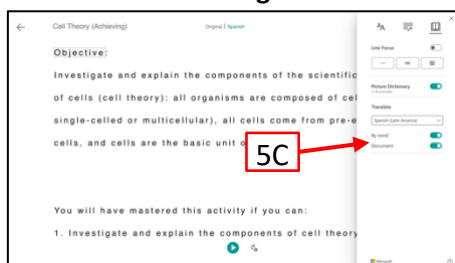
Log into your account with your username and password.

1. Click **Start** to open an activity.
2. Click the blue speaker icon in the bottom left corner to open the Immersive Reader and Language Translator tools.
3. Click the **Text Preferences** icon to change the font style, size, and spacing, or apply a color overlay in the **Themes** section.



4. Click the **Grammar Options** icon to turn on the **Syllables** or **Parts of Speech** overlays.
5. Click the **Reading Preferences** icon to make selections for the **Line Focus** tool, **Picture Dictionary**, and **Language Translator**.

- A. Turn on the **Line Focus** tool and select 1, 3, or 5 lines to be shown.
- B. Turn on the **Picture Dictionary** and click on a vocabulary word to see a visual representation of the word.
- C. To **Translate** the text, turn on **By Word** and **Document**, then scroll through the list to **find and click on the language** you want to translate to.
- D. Click **Play** to listen to the text in the translated language.
- E. The **Picture Dictionary** translates to the selected language. Click the **speaker icon** to listen to the pronunciation of the word in English and the translated language.
- F. Click **Original** or the **translated language** at the top of the screen to toggle between the two languages.



6. Click the back arrow to leave the **Immersive Reader** and **Language Translator** tools.
